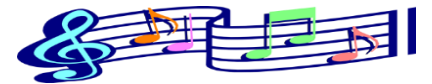

Proud to be a Follower of Jesus

What is the difference between a believer in Jesus and a follower of Jesus?

A believer knows about Jesus & may or may not be saved.

See James 2:18-19 & Luke 6:46

A follower is:

- Dedicated to serving the Lord by obedience to the Word and through serving others.
- A Disciple – a learner
- Has complete obsession – when Knowledge & Belief become experience.

See Luke 9:23-24

Background – The book of Romans

- Romans written about 57 AD from Corinth by Paul
- Only letter to a Church that Paul did not found.
- Systematic Theology of Christian Doctrine – sin, salvation, grace, forgiveness, faith, righteousness, justification, sanctification, redemption, death & resurrection
- Paul's commitment to the gospel

See Romans 1:16-17 & 10:11

Why are we so afraid and why do we act like we are ashamed of the Gospel of Jesus Christ?

1. Like Moses we do not believe in our ability
2. Like Esther, we think it is against the law to speak up
3. We are afraid people might think we are foolish

A follower of Jesus is willing to appear foolish!

For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God. 1 Corinthians 1:18 NIV
