Scripture Isaiah 40:28-31

28 Do you not know? Have you not heard? The Lord is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. He will not grow tired or weary, and his understanding no one can fathom.

29 He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak.

30 Even youths grow tired and weary, and young men stumble and fall;

31 but those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint. NIV

Romans 13:11b-14

... our salvation is nearer now than when we first believed. The night is nearly over; the day is almost here. So let us put aside the deeds of darkness and put on the armor of light. Let us behave decently, as in the daytime, not in orgies and drunkenness, not in sexual immorality and debauchery, not in dissension and jealousy. 17 For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all.

18 So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen. For what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal. NIV

Soar on Wings Like Eagles

Background

- Isaiah means “The Lord saves”
- 1-39 = Judgement for sin
- 40-66 = Forgiveness, Comfort & Hope
- Chapter 39 – The Babylonians would invade Jerusalem,
- Chapter 40 – John the Baptist and Salvation of the Lord

V 28 – God made everything & He is stronger and smarter than us

V 29 & 30 – He is our source, whether we are young or old

V 31 – Hope, renewed strength, soar on wings, run & walk

- **Hope in/wait upon** = To wait expectantly
To trust God completely and serve Him Faithfully

- **Renew** = to exchange weakness for strength
(bad thoughts for good) (dirty clothes for clean)

See Romans 13:11b-14

Augustine – 386 AD a child saying, “Take it and read it.”

He became the Bishop of Hippo

- * God’s strength to revive and refresh us when we feel exhausted from suffering and difficulty

- **Soar on eagle wings** – to rise above the fray and soar

- **Run & Walk spiritually** – Endless energy to continue

All this is possible if we keep our focus on Jesus
